18 and 16 Inch Sheller Trade In Program

On February 13, our government signed into law the *Economic Stimulus Act of 2008*. It is designed to help businesses make investments that otherwise would be delayed or impossible to make this year. In light of this stimulus package, we have elected to write you this letter to highlight a pecan sheller trade in program that we will be offering for a limited time.

Our trade in program is offered only for the Meyer or Modern Electronics 16 inch and 18 inch dial type sheller, and any Savage Equipment sheller of comparable size and capacity that is in working order. Our regular price for the 18" sheller is \$18,600.00. We will reduce this price by \$4,000.00 if you send us your used sheller that meets the requirements above. You will be responsible for the freight on both machines, but we will allow you to use our freight account in an effort to reduce your shipping cost.

We are also offering an option to control the speed of the paddle shaft by means of an additional motor, and variable speed controller. This option carries an additional cost, but it may be advantageous for your operation.

Because we place the quality of our machines at top priority, it is often a long process to improve a machine without diminishing it's expected operation, or it's longevity. We have, however, succeeded in making improvements.

The sheller that we are currently manufacturing still has the same features of the original Meyer sheller with the following exceptions: the frame is now made of rectangular tubing instead of channel. The tubing does not collect dust as the channel did, thus making the machine much easier to clean. Stainless steel is used for the construction of the end plates and the discharge chutes, and the interior parts are no longer painted. The enclosed flyer details some of the improvements we have made to other pieces of equipment.
